



Announcement of The National Institute of Educational Testing Service (Public Organization)

Subject: The Policy of Not Accepting All Kinds of Favors and Gifts from Performing Duties (No Gift Policy) in Fiscal Year 2026.

The National Institute of Educational Testing Service (Public Organization) (NIETS) is the organization that has crucial objectives for educational management and execution related to education, research, and development. In addition, it also continuously proposes educational assessment and testing services as the cooperation center in educational testing, both in domestic and international levels.

In achieving its objectives commitment, NIETS has realized the significance of corruption dilemmas that every public and private sector should cooperate to resolve and terminate these issues. Our organization has courageously created a good-faith culture and honesty values in a workplace according to meritocracy, ethics, conflict of interest resistance, and corrupt behavior prevention. In regard to complying with the Cabinet resolution, policies of the Ministry of Education, and the Organic Act on Anti-Corruption B.E. 2561 (2018), Regulations of the Prime Minister's Office on giving or receiving gifts of government officials B.E. 2565 (2022), the announcement of the National Anti-Corruption Commission on criteria for receiving property or other benefits according to the ethics of government officials, B.E. 2563 (2020), and the relevant code of ethics.

Consequently, NIETS declares, in the subject of steady performance duties and integrity of administrative management for the organization and all official officers, the announcement of not accepting all kinds of favors and gifts from performing duties (No Gift Policy) as follows:

1. All NIETS executives and employed officers, in official and personnel, refrain from giving and accepting all kinds of favors and gifts occasionally and traditionally before, during, and after performing duties. The expression of congratulations, best wishes, welcome, or condolences in chances should be done by signing in blessing cards, blessing books, condolence cards, or using social media channels instead of giving things.
2. All NIETS executives and employed officers have duties to inform outsiders, service clients, and stakeholders about this policy.
3. In any unavoidable cases, they must comply with the Announcement of National Anti-Corruption Commission on criteria for receiving property or other benefits according to the ethics of government officials, B.E. 2563 (2020).
